The following facilities and services are available for students: **Information and Communication Technology (ICT):** As we pioneer the way in the deployment and use of ICT in the region, we remain committed to serving our most coveted client – the KeMU Student. All our campuses are which provide a robust online platform for students registration, access to student grades & records, access to study & research materials, notes, assignments etc. All these facilities will eventually be integrated with a SMART Card system that will be issued to all students as ID Cards and will be used for authentication purposes in accessing the mentioned services. This technology will be extended for administrative functions to other areas such as Hostel Management, Dining Hall, Library, Student Printing/Copying & Scanning, Class Attendance Registry, Access Control, etc. Already in place are state-of-the-art computer labs, digital classrooms, digital libraries among others.

**The Library:** Well stocked libraries across the campuses are provided to give a conducive environment for study and research. They contain over 40,000 volumes of reference works, publications and e-books. The digital libraries are also available to our students.

**Halls of Residence:** These are available to our Main Campus to offer students adequate facilities for boarding.

**Computer Laboratories:** Available across all campuses, they offer services that include but not limited to internet browsing, email, scanning, Scomputer printing and creation of presentations.

**Health and VCT Centre:** Available in our Main Campus the facility offers laboratory services and other general health service to students, staff and the surrounding community.

**Laboratories:** Adequate computer and science laboratories are provided for students and staff.
