Pastry Chef: KeMU/HS/CS/1/1/2024

Duties and Responsibilities:

- i. Preparing a wide variety of food items such as cakes, cookies, pies, bread etc. following standardized and modern recipes
- ii. Preparation of all pastries and snacks for functions, fresh fruit cuts, salads, desserts and tea snacks.
- iii. Creating new and exciting desserts to refresh existing menus and engage the interest of customers
- iv. Modify recipes to meet customers' needs and requests
- v. Decorating pastries using different icings, toppings etc. to ensure the presentation will be beautiful and exciting
- vi. Participate in menu planning and development
- vii. Be accountable for food preparation ingredients
- viii. To execute food control standard in dispensing the established food and pastries portion.
- ix. Ensure that waste is kept at minimal levels by using creative culinary and bakery methods.
- x. Monitoring of stocks for ingredients and make appropriate orders
- xi. To observe safety precautions and kitchen hygiene set standards during food preparation.

- xii. Perform and ensure opening and closing duties are done accordingly.
- xiii. Provide guidance to interns and kitchen stewards.
- xiv. Take kitchen responsibilities in the absence of the head chef
- xv. Perform any other duties assigned by the supervisor.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- i. Set up workstations with all needed ingredients and cooking equipment
- ii. Prepare ingredients to use in cooking (chopping and peeling vegetables, cutting/deboning meat etc.)
- iii. Prepare meals using various utensils/cookers
- iv. Ensure great presentation by dressing dishes before they are served
- v. Serve customers
- vi. Keep a sanitized and orderly environment in the kitchen
- vii. Follow health and safety guidelines
- viii. Monitor stock and place orders when there are shortages
 - ix. Ensure all food and other items are stored properly
 - x. Participate in menu planning and development.
- xi. Able to effectively control the Food & Beverage Cost.
- xii. Control the Food and Beverage outlets in terms of wastage, pilferage and efficiency.
- xiii. Participate in stock taking at the Cafeteria.
- xiv. Perform any other duty assigned by the supervisor.
