SUBJECT : OPENING DATES FOR 3RD TRIMESTER 2025

Reference is made to the above subject matter.

The University examinations for 2nd Trimester 2025 will end on Saturday, 16th August 2025. Students will be in recess for two weeks. The following are important dates to note in regard to 3rd Trimester 2025:

1. Session Reporting

Continuing students are expected to report session from Monday, 25th August 2025 to Friday, 5th September 2025.

2. Registration

New and Continuing students are expected to report and register on Monday, 1st September 2025 to Friday, 5th September 2025. Lectures for the 3rd Trimester 2025 begin on Monday, 8th September 2025. Late registration with penalty runs from Monday, 8th September 2025 to Friday, 19th September 2025.

No registration will be allowed after Friday, 19th September 2025.

3. Add/drop of courses

Add/drop of courses is permissible from Monday, 8th September 2025 to Friday, 26th September 2025 without a penalty. It attracts a penalty in the third week after lectures begin and no student will be allowed to drop/add courses after the third week.

4. Class attendance

Attending lectures, practical sessions and other scheduled classes is mandatory for ALL students, in the relevant modes of study. A student who fails to attend classes for a consecutive or cumulative period of two weeks (or 20% of teaching time – which means at least 80% class attendance in a trimester) will not be allowed to take examinations in that course. Also note that attending or attempting to attend classes or other University services whilst not duly registered is an academic malpractice.



5. Continuous Assessment Tests (CATs)

It is mandatory for ALL students in all modes of study to undertake CATs before sitting for the final examination. No student will be allowed to sit for the final examination without meeting this requirement.
