Programmes objectives

The programme is designed to prepare students to:

- Take up responsibilities in the dynamic hospitality and tourism industry as supervisors and managers.
- Demonstrate leadership and managerial skills and professionalism that will enable them to pursue personal development in specific areas of interest.
- Develop and carry out community programmes and take up leadership roles in their communities in order to lift their standards of living and the community at large.
- Develop managers who will take up entrepreneurial roles in the country and provide employment not only to themselves but to others.

Admission requirements

Those seeking admission are required to have a minimum of C plain in KCSE or its equivalent, or holders of a certificate in Food and Beverage production, Sales and Service, Institutional Management and Hospitality management with a Cumulative GPA of 2.00 and above or its equivalent

Modes of study

The mode of study for this programme is Full Time and Part Time.

Study centres

The programme is available in the following centers

1. Main Campus (Regular and Part-time)

2. Nairobi Campus- KeMU HUB (Regular and Part-time)
3. Nakuru (Regular and Part-time)
4. Mombasa (Regular and Part-time)
5. Nyeri (Regular and Part-time)

Duration of the study

The programme is structured to take (5 semesters) each sixteen weeks or 2 academic years including practicum/ industrial attachment. However, the period can be shortened to (1½) calendar years by registering for the three trimesters in a calendar year.

Intakes per year

The intakes for this programme are January, May and September for part-time and regular students. However, eligible students can apply for admission throughout the year.

Credit transfers

Students who register with a diploma in any of the courses offered for diploma from a reputable institution may be allowed to transfer relevant credits into the programme.

Employment opportunities

The graduates will take up managerial and supervisory jobs in; Hotels, Institutions such as schools, universities, colleges and hospitals, in Transport catering such as marine, airline and railway, Tourists centres and Tour and Travel Operations.
